# **I. Educational Effectiveness Summary Overview**

WCBC currently employs an academic assessment program that maintains a systematic, documented, and sustained assessment process of student learning and program learning outcomes. The academic assessment process involves both formative and summative evaluations utilizing direct and indirect measures of student learning outcomes, and is designed to increase the information flow and facilitate data-based decision making for improvement of curriculum.
