West Coast Baptist College is first and foremost a Christian college that desires to train young men and women to become co-

laborers in the full-time work of Christ. Nearly two thousand students have graduated from WCBC since its founding in 1995.

In recent years, God has graciously given WCBC an unprecedented amount of students to prepare, train, and send into the harvest field. Because of this rapid growth, the need for a student commons building has become overwhelmingly clear.

Currently, our campus is in need of a facility that will expand educational space, while

providing a much-needed center for activities, conferences, and athletic events. It will also serve as the home for campus fellowship and social life. West Coast Baptist College has stepped out by faith to build a state-of-the-art \$7 million student commons building.

This 54,000 square foot facility will be the largest construction project our ministry has undertaken, and it is our prayer that God will use this building for His glory. It will house three side-by-side basketball courts and an event stage with seating for over two thousand spectators. Locker rooms and men's and women's fitness centers will accompany classroom and assembly space, in addition to an on-campus restaurant and dining area.

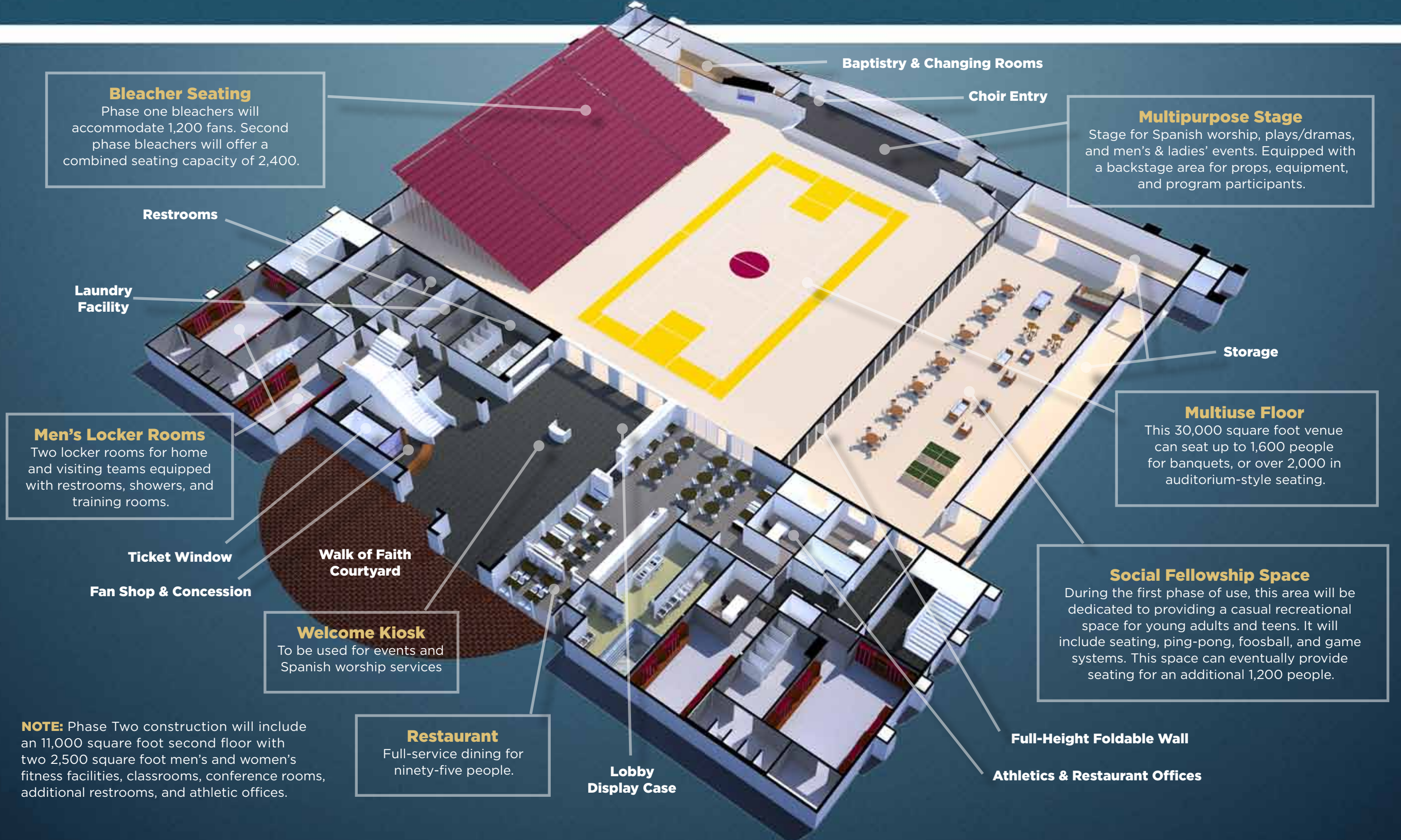

WALTHER CENTER

This 54,000 square foot building will include three side-by-side basketball courts, seating for two thousand spectators, and a full-service restaurant. It will serve nearly every avenue of the ministry.
