2. _____ of Biblical Counseling

A. Forms of Counseling

- 1. From the pulpit—marital or family counseling
- 2. Formal appointments

B. Format for Counseling Session

- 1. Preliminary questionnaire filled out before the session
- 2. Prayer
- 3. Counselee state problem; counselor listens (Daniel 1:19)
- 4. Counselor asks for any clarifications
- 5. Record keeping—keep file on each person
- 6. If more than one session is needed, give assignment and schedule follow-up appointment

3. _____ in Biblical Counseling

- A. All counseling is confidential except if a law is broken that must be reported.
- B. Discern and assess root cause—if a sin issue, go over the sin cycle.

- C. Assess the counselee—submissive to obey Scripture? If counselee is not willing to follow biblical counseling, the counselor is no longer obligated to continue counsel.
- D. Give Bible solutions and biblical repentance and reconciliation principles
- E. Direct counselee to be accountable to Scripture rather than dependent on a counselor.
