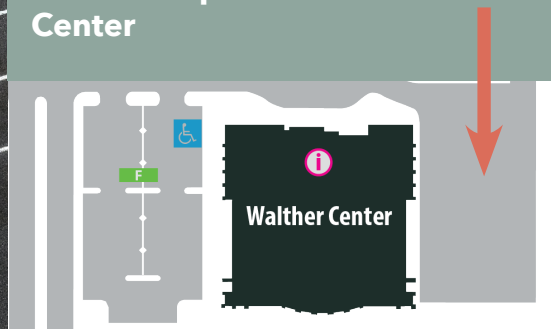

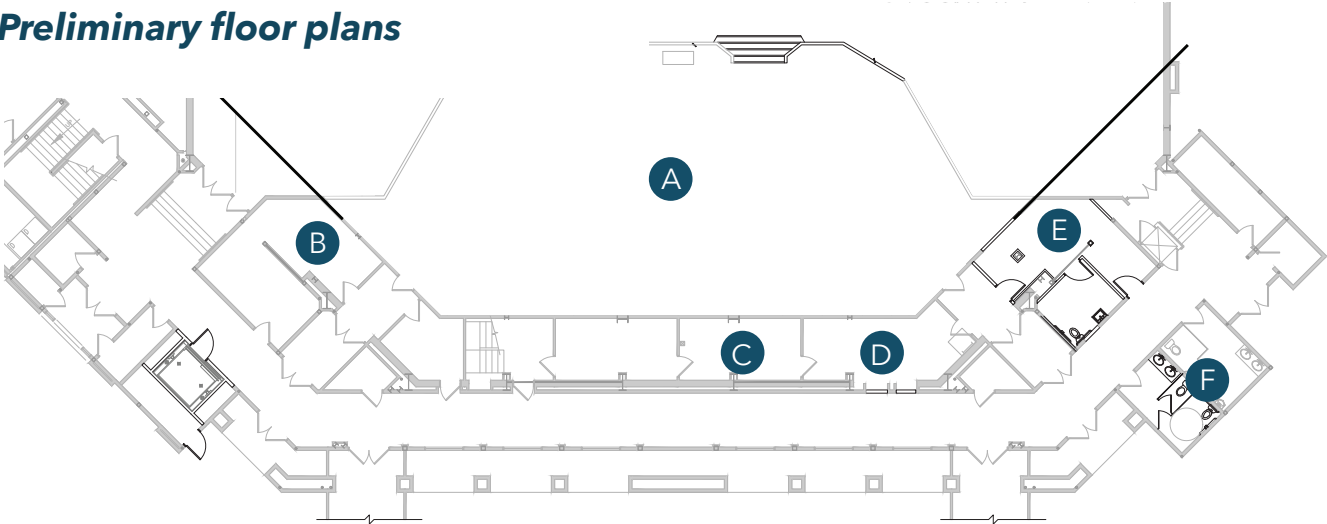

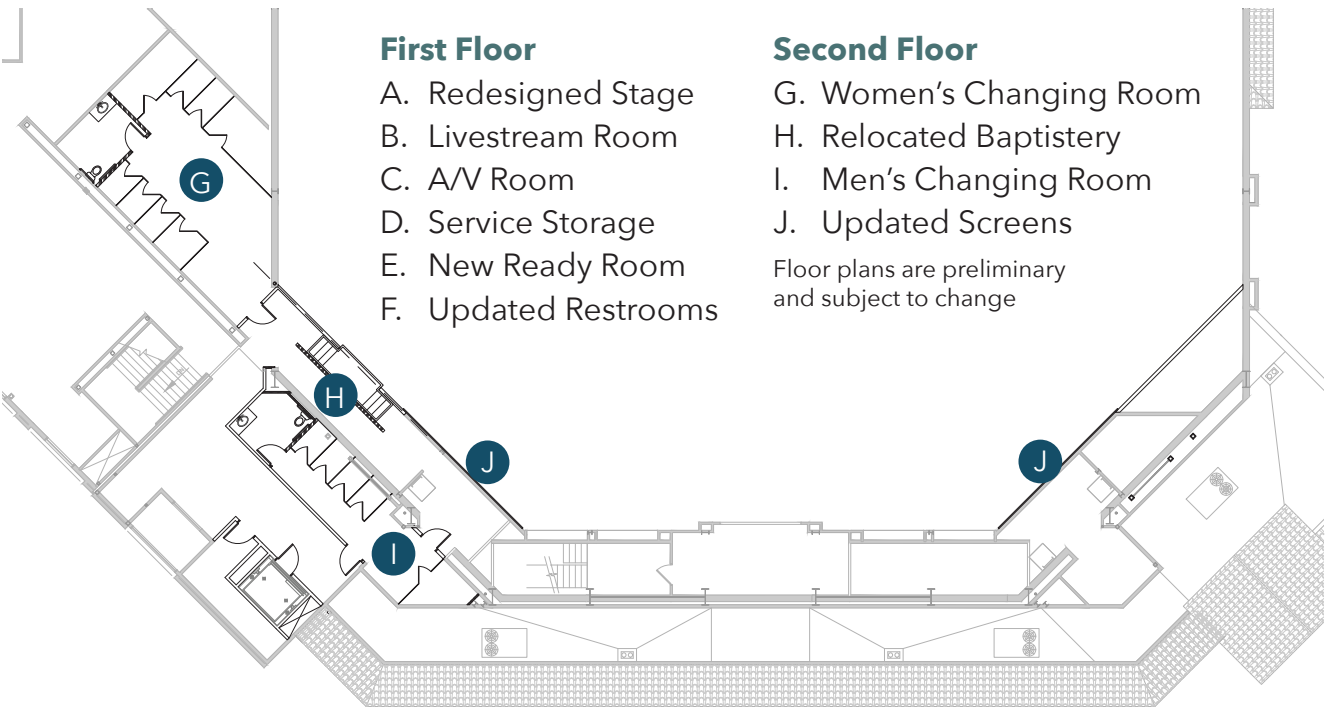

Fellowship Night Hosts and Co-Hosts

Our hosts are being asked to provide a time of fellowship with other members of their Connection Group in their home on the Fellowship Night, February 4.

This is an opportunity for bonding with one another, embracing our vision for the future, and cultivating unity among the body of Christ. This is also a time to seek the Lord in prayer for His power in the lives of our leaders and for His provision in the *Courageous* offering.

Hosts will be provided with a digital presentation, which further develops the theme and our vision for building projects, to be shown at their fellowship

Hosts are responsible to contact those being invited to their homes and, when they RSVP, to provide them with a lapel pin if they have not already received one. The host's list should be kept up-to-date and shared with Brother Fleming's office (Angela Galli) on a weekly basis.

Each host is responsible for determining the menu for refreshments at his or her home. In most cases, it is appropriate to ask those being invited to our homes to bring some type of dish to share. The adult teachers may assist in preparing food and refreshments and in contacting others to participate. The church kitchen will provide paper products (plates, cups, napkins, plastic-ware), in addition to the number of chairs and tables each host requests.

Hosts should seek the assistance of their adult teacher in contacting the members being invited to their homes. Everyone on a Care Group roster is invited to someone's home, not depending on membership.

Fellowship Night Chairs & Tables

Fellowship Night Greeters

The greeters will also be given a list of fellowship locations to help those who do not have a fellowship to attend.

Fellowship Night Nursery Team

The Nursery Childcare Team Leader is responsible for helping provide quality childcare for children 0-35 months during the Fellowship Night. College students will primarily be used for the childcare; however, LBC adult members will be assigned for greeting parents and signing-in their children.

The Team Leader should be present to help children check in and make sure that each worker arrives. Team Leaders will work closely with Christine Allen to provide a welcoming environment for the kids.

Fellowship Night Preschool & Elementary Team

The Preschool & Elementary Childcare Team Leader is responsible for helping provide quality childcare for children ages 3 through 6th grade during the Fellowship Night. College students will primarily be used for childcare; however, LBC adult members will be assigned for greeting parents and signing-in their children.

The Team Leaders should be present to help children check in and make sure that each worker arrives.

Offering Sunday Parking Team

The Parking Lot Team is responsible for directing traffic for February 4 and February 25 before and after all services, morning and evening. They will seek to provide smooth traffic flow as people arrive and depart. Parking spaces close to the building should be reserved for senior saints, handicapped, and special guests.

The Parking Lot Leader should create a schematic of the church campus, identifying the flow of traffic and those positions where each team member will be assigned. The crew should include both existing parking lot crew members and additional volunteers for this special occasion.

Every section in the Worship Center will be assigned a host to ensure everyone in their section is cared for and is connected with. They will meet with their team to train them on how to minister and encourage their assigned section.
