# GRAPHIC DESIGN

## **Student Eligibility**

#### Category

- 1. Tract Design 2 students
- 2. Composite Graphic 2 students

#### **General Rules**

1. All entries must be solely the work of the student entering the competition.

Senior High

- 2. Each entry must have been created since the previous year's competition.
- 3. Entries must meet the guidelines of this competition concerning dress codes and suitable subject matter. No artwork should attempt to portray the face of Christ.
- 4. Students may not enter more than one individual entry.
- 5. All entries must be hard copies. (Computer files are not acceptable.)
- 6. Stock images or artwork may be used in the design of the graphic; however, the final layout must be solely the work of the contestant.
- 7. Each entry will be mounted on black foam board with at least 1-inch border around the project.
- 8. Three judging sheets must be filled out and accompany each entry, along with a 3x5 card containing the entrant's name, school, grade, and category. Each entry must have a plastic sleeve attached (pinned or taped) to the back to protect the three stapled judging sheets.
- 9. An "Artist's Idea Statement" must accompany each judging sheet.
- 10. The judging standard will be as follows:
  - a. Effectiveness
  - b. Creativity
  - c. Use of color
  - d. Use of typography
  - e. Accuracy
  - f. Overall impression

### Rules by Category

#### Category One: Tract Design

Design a tract for your church that would creatively invite members of your community to visit your church. Tracts must be designed in such a way that the finished tract would fit in a standard shirt pocket. Each tract must contain the plan of Salvation (KJV).

#### Category Two: Composite Graphic

Using an application like *Adobe PhotoShop*, create a graphic that would creatively inspire believers in their Christian faith. Graphics should communicate concepts like, but not limited to, God's greatness, hope, faith, mercy, commitment, sacrifice, stewardship, etc.

- 1. All entries must be hard copies and accompanied by the original layered file on CD ROM.
- 2. Final graphic must be eight inches by ten inches and may be laid out either portrait or landscape.
