General Rules for Photography

- 1. The entry may be either a color <u>or</u> black and white print.
- 2. All entries must be a size 8x10 photo or they will be automatically disqualified. The picture must fill this size, not a small picture simply on a size 8x10.
- 3. The photograph must be in good taste.
- 4. A student may enter only one photograph per category and may enter no more than two categories.
- 5. Each photograph must be submitted in a plastic sleeve (no frames).
- 6. Three judging sheets should be filled out and accompany each entry, along with a 3x5 card stapled to the back of the plastic sleeve containing the entrant's name, school, grade, and category.
- 7. An "Artist's Idea Statement" must accompany each judging sheet.
- 8. No item may be entered if it has previously been entered another year.
- 9. All judging forms and CD must accompany the photo at check-in.
- 10. Photographs may be edited in the following areas: color correction, cropping, and exposure.
- 11. The original photo must be submitted on CD in its raw format (please verify the CD on another computer before bringing to the competition).

- 12. If any changes are made, a list of details showing what the student changed must accompany the photograph entered. Every student must make the changes himself. The following must be included in the list of details:
 - a. Program used
 - b. Color Correction: List each step used if the color was changed (what color and what percentage)
 - c. Cropping: What you cropped and why you cropped
 - d. Exposure: Tell if the photo was lightened or darkened and by what percentage
- 13. Distortion and changing of the photograph's content is not allowed.

Causes for Disqualifications

- 1. Not following every direction, including original image, changes, etc.
- 2. No information attached to the entry
- 3. A non-working CD making verification of originality impossible
